These decisions set priorities and allocate resources to drive adaptive management programs that support desired sociocultural, economic, and environmental outcomes. There is an information gap between the decisions Great Lakes leaders make and the results of the programs they influence.

Blue Accounting is a program designed to support strategic decision-making throughout the Great Lakes water system. Led jointly by The Nature Conservancy and the Great Lakes Commission, Blue Accounting seeks to fill the information gap between the decisions Great Lakes leaders make and the outcomes these decisions influence.

The Blue Accounting information management and delivery system will integrate and significantly enhance the Commission's well-established Great Lakes Information Network (www.great-lakes.net) and

You may listen to a replay of the webcast by clicking on the Stewardship Network link above, then on Events and Webcasts, respond to the questions, and listen to the webcast. The question which asks you which group you are with, MBC is part of the Western Lake Erie Cluster. There are a variety of webcasts available at the site ranging from Algal blooms to Garlic Mustard.
