


# From the Auxiliary

# MBC 75th Anniversary Logo

Commodore Hoitash introduced the commemorative 75th Anniversary Logo to the Board during the organizational meeting on Nov 5, and the Board unanimously approved the logo. The club will have numerous opportunities to celebrate our 75th anniversary during the year, with the culmination at the Change of Watch in November 2020.

The logo is an evolution of the club's 70th anniversary image with some elements that make it unique for this special occasion. The club burgee is prominently featured along with a diamond-white "75". The burgee is surrounded by two rings that bring to mind a porthole, common to both power and sailboats, with the name of our club arching overhead.

The federal government includes Bolles Harbor MI on the Official List of Navigable Waters as a Safe Harbor, with Monroe Boat Club being the only named Major Stakeholder in the official description; thus, Bolles Harbor is included as our location in the logo.

The blue waves remind us of the blue Lake Erie waters, and there is a wave for each of the club principals of Promotion, Protection, and Encouragement stated in Section 2 of our bylaws.

Both the 70th and 75th logo's were developed and created by Andrea "AB" Bugelle of Milan, OH in consultation with the Commodore. She comes from a boating family who are members at Sandusky Sailing Club, and she provided MBC with the designs at no cost.
